Practice Overview

Charles practises in commercial, competition and public law. His notable recent instructions include:

- *Municipio de Mariana v BHP Group (UK) Limited* – likely the largest group action ever before the English courts, in which over 600,000 claimants are seeking damages of £36 billion in relation to the collapse of a Brazilian dam (led by Vernon Flynn KC and Richard Eschwege KC) (one of *The Lawyer's* "Top 20 cases" of 2024);
- *Illiquidx Limited v Altana Wealth Limited* – proceedings concerning an opportunity to invest in illiquid assets and alleged breach of confidence (led by Andrew Green KC);
- *Ascentra Holdings, Inc (in Official Liquidation) v Ryunosuke Yoshida and others* – acting for the defendants in the context of a US\$270 million proprietary claim brought by the Cayman Official Liquidators of Ascentra Holdings, Inc (led by Vernon Flynn KC)
